



With tract evangelism...

- You don't have to struggle with how to start a spiritual conversation.
- You won't feel the pressure of trying to express all of the right words.
- You don't have to remember all the right scripture references.
- You are not in charge of what someone does with the Gospel. The decision is always between them and the Lord.

Gospel tracts have been called 'silent preachers' and 'paper missionaries' due to their ability to tell the reader about the Gospel silently, privately, and one-on-one.

Gospel tracts aren't the only way to share your faith, but this can be an excellent, effective tool for you to quietly and effectively witness to others about Jesus.

The Lord commanded us to proclaim the Gospel to every creature . . . and the distribution of a printed piece of Gospel literature (like a GOOD Gospel tract) is an efficient, valuable way to reach a large number of people in the world around you. Passing out Gospel tracts is something that YOU, and every Christian, CAN do.

Here are a few ideas, tips, and suggestions for you:

- Whisper a prayer asking the Lord to help you give one TO the right person, AT the right time, IN the right way.
- Leave a tract with your tip at a restaurant. (If you are NOT a generous tipper do NOT leave a tract. You will leave a poor Christian testimony.)
- Put them in your outgoing mail. Every bill or letter you send through the mail can be an opportunity to also relay the Gospel.
- Hand them to clerks at the check-out stands. Think about all the people who take your money at convenience and grocery stores.
- Hand them to those "other" religious groups who visit your neighborhood wanting to leave their literature with you. You can simply say, "Here, take one of mine."
- Handing out tracts doesn't have to be a planned event in your schedule. It can happen organically throughout your day.
- Keep a few tracts handy in your purse or pocket. AND make a pledge with yourself that they have to be distributed within the next specific day or week.

There are **LIMITLESS** ways and places to hand out tracts, but the important thing is to simply **"DO IT."**

REMEMBER: Good Gospel tracts are often read many times over (even by others) long after they've been given to someone!

Gospel Tracts are definitely one of the staples of evangelism.

Once you make yourself available to hand out tracts a few times, it can eventually become like second nature to you.
